- 6/25 - Visit R&S and TACARE projects in Kigoma with local students
- 6/26 - Travel to Arusha
- 6/27 - Join R&S students in a Swahili lesson and visit African Wildlife Foundation
- 6/28 - Visit with R&S students and learn about their projects in the region
- 6/29 - Visit Moshi town and local market and learn about Mweka Wildlife College
- 6/30 - Visit R&S service and education projects in Kilimanjaro Forest Reserve
- 7/1 - Celebration with local R&S students, cook traditional foods and service
- 7/2 - Safari in Tarangire National Park
- 7/3 - Travel to Ngorongoro Crater for camping safari and visit Maasai Boma
- 7/4 - Game drive in Ngorongoro Crater and return to Arusha
